

California High School Exit Exam

The California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) is a graduation requirement which assesses skills on the California Content Standards for English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics. Students are required to pass both portions of the exam to receive a high school diploma. The goal is to ensure that students receiving a high school diploma can demonstrate grade-level competency in reading, writing, and mathematics. The CAHSEE is another indicator of educational performance in all California school districts and schools.

On March 16 and 17, the California High School Exit Exam will be given to all 10th graders, and all 11th and 12th graders that have not yet taken or passed both portions of the exam. Please try to have your students at school on March 16 and 17 to take the exam. They must bring #2 pencils and their ID cards. As always, students will have better results on exams if they have a balanced breakfast the day of the exam and have received a good night's sleep the night before an exam.

Ninth grade students should report to their period 2/3 classes by 11:21 AM. Students with a period 1 class need to be at school at 7 AM. Period 1 students with lunch time off-campus privileges may leave after Period 1 and return at 11:21 AM for period 2/3.
